## Northwest Grief Tending

### CONSULTING & MENTORSHIP

Individual Consultations	\$80 - \$180 per hour
Group Mentorship	Varies by group size
Facilitator Consult Circle	\$20 - \$50 per session

### GRIEF RITUALS & RETREATS

2-Hour Grief & Gratitude Ritual	\$15 - \$70 per person*
Full Day Grief Ritual	\$80 - \$180 per person*
Weekend Grief Retreat	\$350 - \$500 per person*
Additional Consultations**	\$80 - \$180 per hour

\*The sliding scale ranges listed are typical for these types of gatherings, but final pricing may vary based on a number of factors — including group size (e.g., minimum number of participants required), venue costs, number of facilitators, local cost of living, and travel expenses.

In most cases, a limited number of scholarships or accessibility spots can be offered, depending on the overall group budget.

For rituals lasting one day or longer, a \$250 deposit is required to confirm the date.

\*\*Additional consultations are generally only needed if customization beyond the core ritual format is requested.

## SAMPLE SLIDING SCALE GUIDE

I offer a sliding scale in support of economic justice and accessibility. This model invites your active participation in determining what is equitable for you or your group. Please read the tier descriptions closely and select the rate that best reflects your financial resources and/or limitations.

### **Supporting Tier: \$145 - \$225 / hour**

This tier helps cover the full, holistic costs of community-based services—including sliding scale sessions, need-based support, and BIPOC solidarity scholarships that are built into most of my offerings. It also supports the facilitator's long-term sustainability and thriving. Please choose this tier if you are able to comfortably meet all your needs and have the means to support greater economic justice across our programs.

### **Sustaining Tier: \$145 / hour**

This tier reflects the direct cost of the service and ensures fair, sustainable compensation for the facilitator. It may be right for you if you regularly meet your basic needs (food, housing, etc.) and have access to income, transportation, financial savings, and health care. If you're able to comfortably meet your needs and have the means to support greater economic justice, please consider the Supporting Tier above, which helps cover the holistic costs of community offerings.

### **Supported Tier: \$80 - \$145 / hour**

This tier is designed to support economic accessibility and reduce financial barriers. It does not fully cover the cost of services but is made available to support individuals and groups with limited access to resources. It may be right for you if you frequently experience financial stress, have limited savings, or struggle to meet basic needs. If you are able to comfortably or regularly meet your needs, please select at the higher tier to help cover the costs of services.
